SPARKLING

Grand C - Crémant d'Alsace Rosé Brut - Pinot Noir - Alsace, France

£7 / 9 / 28

Méthode Traditionelle - 24 months on the lees. Fresh and elegant, bursting with wild berries, red currant, cherry and slight creamy finish.

Best Practice

Grand C - Crémant d'Alsace Blanc Pinot Gris Extra Sec - Alsace, France

£7 / 9 / 28

Méthode Traditionelle - 18 months on the lees. Fresh and fruity with notes of apple, pear, citrus and apricot, accompanied by a hint of floral, spice and fine minerality. Dry with a hint of sweetness.

Fattoria di Montemaggio - Cielo di Montemaggio Spumante 2020 - Chianti, Italy

Chardonnay. This is a fresh and easy drinking sparkling wine, with notes of Granny Smith apples, honeysuckle, and lively acidity.

Canta Rainette - Caprice Blanc Extra Brut NV - Chardonnay - Provence, France

Chardonnay. Traditional method sparkling wine with a pleasant floral nose of blossom and honeysuckle, followed by crunchy apple, hints of citrus and subtle brioche. Fine and persistent bubbles.

Clos Jangli - Crémant de Luxembourg Rosé Brut 2018 - Moselle, Luxembourg

Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir. Intense strawberry and raspberry, with a hint of cream and brioche, balanced by refreshing acidity. Full body and long finish.

Johanninger - Riesling Brut NV - Rheinhessen, Germany

A traditional method dry sparkling wine with bright tropical notes and crisp acidity, followed by hints of brioche and a slight nuttiness - over 5 years bottle ageing.

Greyfriars - Sparkling Sauvignon Blanc 2017 - Surrey, UK

A very special bottle from our friends at Greyfriars, in Surrey. Made in the traditional method, expect fresh florals such as elderflower and blossom, alongside gooseberries, asparagus, and citrus - a perfect summer wine.

Champagne De Lozey - Tradition Brut - Champagne, France

£11 / 14 / 41

Pinot Noir, Chardonnay. Fresh and floral, with notes of white flowers, bergamot and blanched almonds. Blended with 20% 15-year-old wine, from a solera, brings the complexity of a much more mature Champagne.

Greyfriars - Rosé Reserve NV - Pinot Noir & Chardonnay - Surrey, UK

From the Surrey Hills, near Guildford, Greyfriar's Rosé Reserve is fresh and fruity with candied strawberry and raspberry aromas, a hint of cream on the mid-palate and beautifully balanced acidity.

Greyfriars - Blanc de Blancs 2015 - Chardonnay - Surrey, UK

Left for on the lees for 5 years, this is a complex and well-rounded traditional method sparkling wine from the the Surrey Hills. Notes of baked apples and lemon peel, alongside brioche and a hint of cream on the mid-palate. Vibrant bubbles and a long finish.

Thierry Perrion - Extra Brut Grand Cru Champagne - Verzenay, Champagne, France

Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay. Ripe apples, hint of red berries, and a touch of honey. Fine mousse bubbles and balanced acidity.

Fresh and floral with white flowers, blossom, fleshy white peach and a touch of toasted oak.

Grand C - AOC Alsace Riesling Sec 2021 - Alsace, France

Dry and refreshing, with notes of pear, lemon, grapefruit, hints of mango and lively citrus.

Expressive nose of nectarine and tropical fruits, notes of honey suckle and lightly mineral finish.

Powerful and elegant with aromas of yellow flesh fruits, vanilla and a hint of blossom. Voluptuous with a buttery mid-palate and fine acidity.

Fresh and expressive with notes of grapefruit, lime and cut grass. A subtle hint of toasted oak and an elegant, mineral finish.

Clos Jangli - Pinot Gris Grand Premier Cru 2021 - Moselle, Luxembourg

Refreshing and vibrant with notes of lime, nectarine, a touch of honeysuckle, cream and minerality.

Johanninger - Röemerhelde Chardonnay 2018 - Nahe, Germany

A full-bodied chardonnay with notes of pear, honeydew melon and oak. Round and luscious on the palate with a long finish.

Uncle's - Chardonnay 2020 - Nahe, Germany

Full and round with notes of peach and yellow apple, alongside hints of butterscotch and subtle oak.

Lively acidity and a long finish.

Grand C - AOC Alsace Grand Cru Eichberg Riesling 2019 - Alsace, France

Dry with an opulent nose of citrus, pineapple and yellow stone fruits. Fine structure and silky finish.

Vibrant minerality and fresh notes of pear and pineapple are followed by a creamy mid palate with hints of oak and butterscotch. A long, enticing finish.

56WS Rosé 2022 - Grenache/Cinsault/Syrah/Tibouren - Provence, Fr.

Reminiscent of St Tropez, our rosé is light and fruity with an abundance of juicy red fruit alongside balanced, fresh acidity.

Château Lauzade Rosé - 2022 - Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah - Provence, Fr.

£8 / 10 / 30

An expressive pale pink rosé, bursting with raspberries and apricots. It offers subtle aromatics, alongside a fresh savouriness and balanced acidity.

Domaine de Bourrian - Cuvée Inspiration 2021 - Grenache/Cinsault/Syrah - Provence, Fr.

Gentle pale peach colour, notes of yellow apricot, grapefruit, strawberry, freesia and subtle orange peel.

- 56WS Red 2014 - C.Sauvignon/Syrah/Mourvèdre - Provence, France £6 / 8 / 25
Powerful and full bodied, notes of black cherry and plums, leather, spice and oak.
Organic, Awards: Silver Medals in Paris 2016 and Lyon International 2017
- Château de la Cômbe - Cuvée Lady Séverine 2017 - C.Sauvignon/Syrah - Provence, France £7 / 9 / 27
Sweet and delicate tannins with notes of blackberry and hints of black pepper and Burlat cherry. Medium bodied, elegant ruby colour with purple highlights.
Organic, Awards: Gold Medals in Paris 2019 and Macon 2019
- Château de la Cômbe - IGP Pure Cab 2020 - C.Sauvignon - Provence, France £7 / 9 / 27
A beautifully balanced Cab Sav with bright red fruits like cherry, strawberry and a hint of violet, alongside notes of balsamic, chocolate, coffee and spice.

- Alves de Sousa - Gaivosa Primeiros Anos 2020 - Touriga Nacional/Tinta Amarela - Portugal £7 / 9 / 27
A full bodied wine of 13 indigenous grapes, with intense black fruit, blackberry and violet, alongside vanilla, oak, and a hint of liquorice, dark chocolate and spice.

- Vinhos de Darei - Largar de Darei Red Reserva 2015 - Dão, Portugal £7 / 9 / 27
A blend of four local Portuguese grapes; Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, Alfrocheiro, Jaen.
An explosion of juicy fruits such as blackberry, black plum and cherry, alongside hints of prune and earth. The wine is well balanced with good acidity and medium tannins. Incredibly fresh for its age.

- Fattoria di Montemaggio - Chianti Classico 2015 - Sangiovese/Merlot - Tuscany, Italy £7 / 9 / 27
An intense, elegant bouquet, earthy, mineral, spiced with wild notes typical of Sangiovese grapes.

- Château de la Cômbe - Cuvée St Georges 2017/18 - Syrah/C.Sauvignon - Provence, France £7 / 10 / 31
Juicy black fruits, hints of spice, coffee and cocoa. Intense vanilla and smoky aromas.

- Château de la Cômbe - Cuvée la Combe 2015 - C.Sauvignon/Syrah - Provence, France £7 / 10 / 31
Full and warm with aromas of chocolate and red fruit, walnuts, prunes and toasted oak. Velvety tannins and perfectly integrated noble oak.

Fattoria di Montemaggio - Chianti Classico Riserva 2014 - Sangiovese/Merlot - Italy

Elegant, rich, and velvet smooth. A bouquet of rich floral notes with hints of fruits. Pleasant tannins and a well-balanced palate with persisting presence.

Clos Jangli - Pinot Noir Sincera 2018 - Moselle, Luxembourg

£9 / 12 / 36

An abundant nose of red cherries, currants and vanilla, followed by spicy undertones and a touch of earthiness. Refreshing acidity and tight tannins.

Torres di Montemaggio - Super Tuscan 2018 - Merlot - Tuscany, Italy

Fresh and floral on the nose, with an abundance of black fruit and violet, followed by a hint of oak and spice. Full bodied with medium tannins and balanced acidity.

Alves de Sousa - Vale da Raposa Touriga Nacional 2017 - Douro, Portugal

£10 / 13 / 41

Bold and complex, with notes of fresh black fruits, prune and subtle spices of cardamom and liquorice and a hint of coffee. Smooth tannins and a long finish.

Alves de Sousa - Quinta da Gaivosa Porto White 10 Years Old - Douro, Portugal

£9 / 11 / 33

Bold and refined with notes of dried orange peel, maple syrup and almonds, alongside hints of spice and herbs. Aged for 10 years in French oak barrels. Delicious with blue cheese or as a post dinner drink.

Alves de Sousa - Quinta da Gaivosa Porto 10 Years Old Tawny - Douro, Portugal

£9 / 11 / 33

Complex and charming with notes of caramel, macerated raspberries, roasted nuts, ginger and spices. Smooth and round with a long finish.

Alves de Sousa - Quinta da Gaivosa Porto Late Vintage Port Ruby - Douro, Portugal

£7 / 9 / 35

Deep aroma with notes of dried black plums, macerated sour cherries, dried figs, eucalyptus leaf and dark chocolate. Great depth and complexity with a very long finish.
